WRWSD Board of Trustees Meeting – Mon., August 29, 2016

President Jim Bridges called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Present: Beard, Beresford, Bridges, Buskey, LaPlante, Purdin, Redick, Mgr. Cahall and

Plant Supt. Culver

Absent: none

Minutes: A motion was made by LaPlante and seconded by Beard to approve the minutes of the August 13th Saturday meeting as distributed via email. A yea/nay vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

President's Report (Jim Bridges): none

Treasurer's Report (John Buskey): Delinquent WRWSD accounts (water availability fees, sewer assessments, etc.) will be certified for collection by the Brown County Auditor in early September. In August the District received a check for \$7403.64 from the Brown County Auditor. The amount received from the Auditor for the collection of delinquent WRWSD accounts for all of 2016 totaled \$25,753.00.

Report from the Manager (Paul Cahall) and Plant Supt. (George Culver):

- A water leak in Atoka Cove was located and repaired. Reclamation of the yard and driveway still need to be done.
- Repairs to the gate at the water/sewer plant will be done once the parts are received.
- The 1998 Chevrolet truck sold on GovDeals.com for \$6125.00. The payment will be divided and deposited equally in the water and sewer reserve funds.
- Cahall and Culver shared that a new 'hire' is now working for the WRWSD. The 'summer help' has gone back to school.
- Cahall shared the concerns of a WRWSD customer with the Trustees.

New Business:

- The Board determined that there would be a quorum at the September 10th meeting even though three Trustees will not be in attendance.
- Bridges noted that he had been a part of a meeting with our State Senator, Joe Uecker, who is aware of the water issues causing concern for the Ohio EPA.
- Beard commented that his neighbor was appreciative of the response he received from the WRWSD staff in regards to an issue.

Old Business: Buskey and the Trustees discussed with Cahall and Culver the status of various capital improvement projects for 2016 which have not yet been completed.

Motions and Resolutions: none

Adjournment: At 6:32 pm a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Purdin and seconded by Beard. All were in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
