
IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Treasurer Report Month Ending-March 2020

Operating Funds

March total operating income was \$423,000.00.

March total operating expenses were \$116,000.00 with no unexpected expenses.

Operating fund balance at the end of March was \$693,533.49

Operating income for the year at the end of March was \$810,000.00. That is 37% of the plan for 2020. Expected income at the end of March was 49% so we are 12% under budget. This shortfall was caused by the office being closed the last two weeks of March for COVID 19.

Operating expense for the year at the end of March was \$449,000.00. That is 21% of the plan for 2020. Expected expense at the end of March was 21% so we are right on budget.

Allocated Assessment Funds

Income for allocated operating assessments in March were \$218,000.00

Assessment account expenditures in March totaled \$49,000.00. This was used for the following. Purchased a new mower, Tree work on campground, Dock replacement and repair, Dam work.

Balance of all allocated assessment accounts at the end of March were \$494796.43

Invested Funds

Invested Reserves at the end of March totaled \$479,973.13

Total cash on hand at the end of March was \$1,668,305.05

Managers' Report-March 2020

At the time of writing this report we are still in the middle of a "stay at home" order from the Governor. While I support the Governor's order, I like many of you am ready to go back to something close to normal and get the season kicked off. We have been busy cleaning and repairing our facilities so that as soon as it is possible to reopen them, we can quickly get them open.

A reminder while we have waved late fees for the month of April if you have not paid your 2020 dues and renewed your RFID stickers they will stop working at midnight on the 30th of April.

The valve on the main lake was opened on 14 April and will be open for 7 to 10 days for draining of the lagoon. This should result in a temporary drop in lake level of less than a foot.

The Administration Office is now operating under summer hours. The office is to be open Monday through Friday 8 am to 4 pm, and Saturday 8 am to noon. Currently, we are conducting business only by phone and the drive-up window.

We will be assigning rental docks the morning of 1 May at 8 am on a first come first serve bases. We will be enforcing social distancing during this operation allowing only one customer at a time in the office.

Someone will be stationed outside to help keep things organized and people separated.

The rustic bathrooms at the recreation areas are open. The current plan is to have the bathroom at the beach open on 1 May.

The campground is currently closed but we have been hard at work making sure it will be ready to open within 48 hours of being given the ok from the Ohio department of Health. Power and water is shut off in the campground at this time and will not be turned until we are given the ok from the State.

Other News from Security/Police

The Security Office is currently issuing all WPOA decals. The major changes to our operations at this point have been eliminating contact with members and visitors by speaking to them through the intercom system and using the sliding drawer to complete transactions. This has worked well and will continue till 5/1/2020 or until we receive different orders from the government concerning social distancing.

We are currently issuing new RFID decals to members but will not be installing them in the vehicles. The member will have to install the decal. Security personnel will assist with verbal directions for placement.

In Police News, approximately 1 day after Gov. DeWine ordered all bars and restaurants closed, two individuals drove to the security office and requested entry into the community to patronize the Waynoka Lounge, the gate guard on duty noticed that the individuals appeared to be intoxicated along with receiving a phone call from a concerned member who had been following the vehicle, Gate Guard Bob Millisor summoned Sgt. Mckinzie who attempted to stop the vehicle before it left the community and a short pursuit ensued. With the help of the Brown County Sheriff's Office and the Ohio State Highway Patrol the vehicle was stopped and the driver was arrested for OVI, driving under suspension, failure to comply and open container in a motor vehicle. Is the Color Run Safe?

The color powder is non-toxic, non-hazardous and 100% safe Holi color powder. The products are made from natural cornstarch with color dyes that are food and cosmetic grade-tested to the highest FDA standards.

What to bring and wear at the Color Run/Walk?

- 1. Wear white clothes! This will help you show off your colorful self!
- 2. Wear any crazy clothes, boas, hats, tutus. This is to show off your colorful self!
- 3. Olive oil or conditioner for your hair! This will help the color stay on the surface.
- 4. Sunglasses to protect your eyes. This is a MUST! (Child glasses provided)
- Wear old shoes!
- 6. Flip flops for after the race.
- Bring a plastic bag for painted clothes if you intend to change.
- Change of clothes.
- 9. Baby wipes to wipe off face.

How to take care of your clothes.

Dust or blow off most of the powder before using water. (Blowers will be provided) The color may or may not wash out of your clothes. As with anything dirty, the sooner you wash it the better. We suggest wearing clothing that you wouldn't mind getting colorful.

Cleaning your hair starts with blowing and brushing out any loose powder. Rinse out the oil/conditioner you wisely applied before the race with COLD water. Now wash your hair as usual. It is not uncommon for hints of some of the color, pink and purple particularly, to stick around for a few washes. If you want it to stay spray with vinegar and dry before washing.
